- Upon completion of course: Students gain entrance into a Registered Apprentice Program and the opportunity to work as an Apprentice Electrician with on-the-job training.

- 37 Wk Course (129 hours).
- 129 hour course includes 69 lecture hours & 60 lab hours.
- Upon completion of course: Students gain entrance into a Registered Apprentice Program and the opportunity to work as an Apprentice Plumber with on-the-job training.

##### PROCESS OPERATOR PROGRAM:

- 1 Yr Course (144 hours).
- 144 hour course includes 82 lecture hours and 62 lab hours.
- Upon completion of course: Students gain entrance into a Registered Apprentice Program and the opportunity to work as a Process Operator with on-the-job training.
